**LEGAL SERVICES HONORS DONORS AND PRO BONO ATTORNEYS AT SECOND ANNUAL
MID-HUDSON PARTNERS IN JUSTICE RECEPTION**

Legal Services of the Hudson Valley (LSHV) will present its Second Annual "Mid-Hudson Partners in Justice Reception" at Anthony's Pier Nine in New Windsor, NY on Wednesday, October 24th, 2007 from 5:30 – 7:30 pm. The "Partners in Justice Reception" seeks to recognize and thank the generous donors and *pro bono* attorneys whose support for LSHV is essential to the continued success of its mission to provide high quality legal services to underserved individuals and families throughout the Hudson Valley, including Dutchess, Ulster, Orange and Sullivan Counties. A similar awards program and reception has been a tradition in the Westchester/Putnam/New York City region, and LSHV is happy to be continuing the tradition by honoring the donors and volunteers in Mid-Hudson Valley who are vital in ensuring the ability of LSHV to provide legal services to the indigent.

The first "Partner in Justice Award" will be presented to Finkelstein and Partners and will be accepted by Partner Andrew Finkelstein. Finkelstein and Partners has been a staunch supporter of Legal Services of the Hudson Valley and has helped promote our Access to Justice Campaign with a goal of \$1 million. Partner George Levy has served on the Campaign Committee for the past two years. To date, 800,000 has been raised towards that goal. Finkelstein and Partners created the idea of a monthly gift in perpetuity to Legal Services of the Hudson Valley. This model has been used by other law firms donating to the campaign also. The award will be presented by LSHV Board of Directors Member and Access to Justice Committee Chairperson David Posner, Esq., a partner at the Poughkeepsie based law firm of McCabe and Mack.

For excellent *Pro Bono* Services provided to the clients of LSHV, a Partners in Justice Award will be presented by LSHV Deputy Director Lewis Creekmore to Mary Patricia Papini Guidetti, Esq., Law Offices of Mary Patricia Papini Guidetti. Her office is in Middletown, NY.
